



Dehesa Charter School's Annual CATALINA CIMI Toyon Bay & Cherry Cove Camping Trip 5 Toyon or 3 Cherry Cove Day Option

WHO: Dehesa students between grades 5-12 may attend 3 day option. Students who wish to attend the 5 day option must be in 8th grade or higher (exceptions may be made for middle school students who have successfully completed the 3 day trip). Please note that both 3 and 5 day options require rigorous physical activity.

WHAT: Students will leave from Long Beach (parents are responsible for transportation to and from Long Beach) and take a ferry boat over to Catalina Island where they will participate in a three day, two night, **OR** a five day, four night camping adventure. Students hike to the camp site and sleep in tents. They are kept busy exploring this wonderful island. Your child will embark upon an adventure that will not only teach marine science and island ecology, but stimulate curiosity for nature and become a treasured memory.

The program consists of a series of half day activities which include snorkeling, island ecology hikes, oceanography, marine biology labs, and ocean kayaking.

Your student is accompanied by Dehesa Charter School Educational Facilitators and the CIMI Cherry Cove professional staff.

WHEN: Three-day option (for students in grades 5-12): March 21-23, 2012
Five-day option (ONLY for high school students and middle school students that have successfully completed the 3 day trip): March 19-23, 2012

COST: Three-day trip cost \$245 EUs per student
Five-day trip cost \$430 EUs per student
